
Goatry a boon to Sunderbai



Korku CFCDP is effectively working in Melghat region, Amravati for income and livelihood generation of the community. A woman named Sunderbai of Chippoli Village, Dharni and member of Vidya Mahila Bachat Ghat, narrates her success story.

“I am a labourer having no land and take land on lease @ Rs. 1000/- per acre per year and cultivate it for meeting the basic requirements of my family. During the first year of Korku CFCDP intervention, I was provided with a goat through the SHG programme. By the third year, I had 11 goats of which I sold 3 for Rs 9000.00. This was an additional income for me, with which I was able to take land on lease, water pipe connections and be able to look after the needs of my family.”

Sunderbai, now wants to increase the number of goats as it is a regular income for her. Every year, if she can sell 4 goats, she says, she can earn an additional income of around Rs. 10,000 to Rs. 12,000.
